

You can now switch to the DSF video and back to the PPT in just SIX EASY steps!!!

### **SIX EASY steps!**

1. **POINT** the remote control to the DVD player and **PRESS** the **POWER** button on the remote.
2. **POINT** the remote control to the DVD player and **PRESS ENTER** to select **MOVIES** on the menu.
3. **POINT** the remote control to the DVD player and **PRESS** the **DISC MENU** button.
4. **POINT** the remote control to the DVD player and **PRESS ARROW LEFT** or **RIGHT** to select the correct language.
5. **POINT** the remote control to the DVD player and **PRESS ENTER** to select the correct language.
6. **POINT** the remote control to the DVD player and **PRESS** the **POWER** button to exit the video and go back to the PPT on the laptop.

The steps above are all you need to do to show the DSF video. But please read on to understand the set-up, what is already connected, what you need to do AND what NOT to do and why.

### **KNOW**

What you need to know before operating:

1. You will need to set up the laptop and run the PPT as usual. We know this by heart.
2. You **DO NOT NEED** to set up the DVD player. It is on top of the black audio/ video box and is already hooked up. GREAT!  
**You will only need to find the DVD player's remote control.** The remote control is the only way you can get to the correct DSF video. ALWAYS leave the remote control on top of the DVD player when not in use.
3. You no longer need the VIDEO selector. Yay! The DVD player is connected directly to the video box through an HDMI cable. The video box will automatically select the DVD player input when the player is POWERED ON. The video box will automatically go back to the PPT on the laptop when the DVD is POWERED OFF.
4. When using the DVD's remote control, **ALWAYS** point it to the DVD player and NOT to the screens. It will only work if you point it to the DVD player. There is a green light indicator on the player that blinks each time a button on the remote is pressed. If the light indicator doesn't blink when you press a button, you may not be pointing the remote correctly to the player or you may be too far.
5. The DSF dvd is already in the DVD player. Please **DO NOT** remove the dvd from the player.
6. Keep the door to the back room open so you can see the DVD player from the church's exit by the cantor stand. Why? Please read on.

### **CHECK**

AFTER setting up the PPT on your laptop and BEFORE the Mass starts, make sure to check the following:

1. DVD player POWER is OFF.
2. DVD remote is on top of the DVD player. Familiarize yourself with the following buttons on the remote control: POWER, ENTER, ARROW right and left and DISC MENU.
3. Black box is switched ON.
4. Door to the back room is OPEN.

Run the PPT on the laptop as usual. After the homily, when the priest asks for the DSF video, position yourself by the exit just behind the cantor stand so that you have a view of the screen as well as the DVD player that is on top of the black box.

### **SIX EASY steps!**

1. **POINT the remote control to the DVD player and PRESS the POWER button on the remote.**

This will power ON the DVD player. The dvd player menu (not the DSF video menu) should pop up automatically on the screen once the DVD player is powered ON. Wait for about 5 seconds for the player to read the disc.

2. **POINT the remote control to the DVD player and PRESS ENTER to select MOVIES on the menu.**

The player will immediately start the video. Do not hit PLAY, STOP or PAUSE. As soon as the video starts playing, do STEP 3.

3. **POINT the remote control to the DVD player and PRESS the DISC MENU button.**

This will allow you to choose the correct language and play the video from the very beginning.

The player automatically uses the settings from the last time it played the video and even picks up from where it stopped. For example, if the Spanish video was selected and shown at the previous Mass, the player will automatically play the Spanish video after you select MOVIES on the menu. To choose the correct language, go to step 4.

4. **POINT the remote control to the DVD player and PRESS ARROW LEFT or RIGHT to select the correct language.**

The dvd contains the DSF video in the following languages: English, Spanish and Vietnamese. The language that is selected is RED.

5. **POINT the remote control to the DVD player and PRESS ENTER to select the correct language.**

The screen should show the DSF video from the beginning. The video is about 8 minutes long. If you missed the desired language, do steps 3, 4 and 5.

6. **POINT the remote control to the DVD player and PRESS the POWER button to exit the video and go back to the PPT on the laptop.**

At the end of the video, simply press the POWER button. There is no need to press the STOP or PAUSE button on the remote. When you power OFF the dvd player, it does several things at once: STOPS the video, Turns off the dvd player, and cuts off the dvd player's signal on the video box causing the video box to go back to showing the PPT on the laptop.
