As St. Mary Magdalene continues to grow as a Catholic community here in Humble, it is important that we continue to evaluate the needs of our parish. You will recall that we conducted a survey two years ago with the help of HBL Architect, which helped determine the needs of our community. With that in mind, we are moving forward with a Feasibility Study to examine the possibility of conducting a capital campaign to build a new multi-purpose building.

Such an effort requires thoughtful planning to ensure success. I am seeking the advice of our parishioners of St. Mary Magdalene and your input is essential. Your opinions, and those of fellow parishioners will help us to continue toward our parish vision that was established by our founding members. Together, we can make well-informed decisions about the future of our parish.


To assist us, the parish has retained Guidance In Giving, Inc., a professional Catholic development organization, to work with our staff in coordinating all aspects of the Feasibility Study. Your response in this study will be seen only by Guidance in Giving staff and not by myself or any of the parish staff. Based on opinions and input found during this process, the firm will guide us in formulating a plan of action and will make recommendations regarding our next steps in implementing a successful capital campaign.

Enclosed you will find a Feasibility Study Survey, which includes a "Proposal Project Summary". I ask that you complete the Survey and return it to the parish no later than "Survey Weekend," April 29th – 30th. This survey is also available online at www.st-mm.com and click on "Parish Feasibility Study" on the home page (password: humble).

The questions in the study are intended to assist the parish in obtaining an accurate view of the feelings, opinions and financial support of our parishioners toward a proposed campaign. Once you have completed your survey, you may place your survey in the weekend collection basket, return it through the mail or bring it to the parish office. I have enclosed a return envelope for your use. Be assured that, at this stage, this is not a formal solicitation. A campaign will not begin until after the results of the Feasibility Study have been presented to the parish and we are confident in the ability to move forward.

I thank you in advance for your advice and counsel as we make plans for the future of St. Mary Magdalene. I ask that you keep this study in your prayers and I thank you so much for your support.
